Felbury Centre, Holmbury St Mary, Surrey Hills

The Felbury Centre is the activity base for The Lifetrain Trust, a charity working to benefit young people through the outdoor environment. Felbury provides an excellent teaching base for the provision of a wide variety of personal and social development for young people, such as Youth Achievement Awards as well as youth workers NVQ's and other training.

Ideally located in the midst of the Surrey Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty near the village of Holmbury St Mary, Felbury's location in the centre of the best range of riding across the South East of England means that we have a plethora of trail choices from the door: ideal for both the Trail Leader and Technical Leader courses.



Accommodation:

Felbury provides the multi-day courses on a residential basis, including food and accommodation from Friday evening through to Sunday late afternoon. Accommodation is based in ensuite twin or triple rooms. The entire centre was designed with disabled people in mind, so is fully accessible.
