CTC Go-mtb Leader Orientation Support Resources



This document is designed to aid your understanding of what happens following your CTC Go-mtb Leader Orientation course, and how you can access the Go-mtb resources.

Note that many of the resources for the Go-mtb scheme are provided by Cycling Scotland, as partners of CTC in delivering the Go-mtb scheme. They can be contacted at 0141 229 5350.

Logging in

Prior to your Go-mtb Leader Orientation, you were asked to register on the CTC course at the Cycling Scotland website. At this point, you will have determined your own username and password. A copy of these should then also have been sent to you by email.

Please use these details to log into your account for all Go-mtb related information.

- Go to www.cyclingscotland.org.
- From the home page, select the 'Training courses' option at the bottom left
- Then click the leader '*home page here*' link in the right hand column.

If you forgot to register at the Cycling Scotland website before your course, you will need to wait until your course review is complete. As part of this review, CTC will register you as attending on your course, and you will be sent an email asking you to choose your own username and password for future access to the site.

Your Certificate

Following your course, you will be issued with a certificate to download. You will be notified of the availability of this by email from Cycling Scotland. Due to the course review process and our internal standards verification, this can take up to five weeks at very busy times, although we aim to complete the process more quickly most of the time.

For verification of your course attendance and for participant training purposes, the yellow copy of your CTC course review is sufficient.

Registering participants

To register your Go-mtb participants:

- Log on to www.cyclingscotland.org as defined in [logging in](#)
- Click on the 'Go Mountain Bike Instructor Page' link
- Select 'Order Resources' and go through the process as required.
- Click on the appropriate choice within 'my centres'
- You can then 'add candidates', followed by 'issue certificates' as required.

Ordering resources

To order certificates, posters and participant logbooks, you will first need to be registered as a centre. This is required to ensure that purchasing, invoicing and payment of resources is robust.

You should have recorded your centre during your Go-mtb Orientation course, but if not, or where you move centres, please contact Cycling Scotland before ordering.
